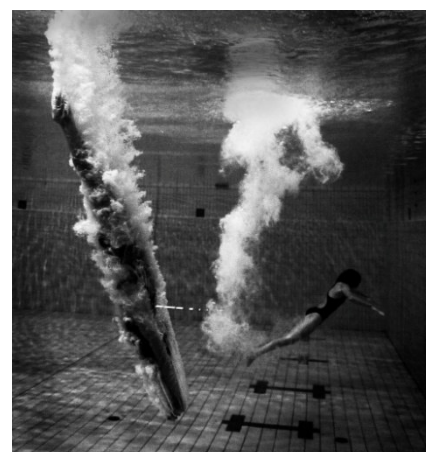

## President's Report

In my capacity as Vice President of Diving Queensland, and with the resignation of the incumbent Paul Stafford from the President's role, it is my pleasure to provide the following report on some of the activities of Diving Queensland since this time last year. DQ is in the first year of the three year cycle of the State Government Development Funding Programme. The Board agreed on a Strategic Plan and subsequent Operations Plan to enable funding to be approved, so we are very grateful to be able to continue with our plans as outlined in those documents.

## Clubs

After introducing the Future Directions incentive over 12 months ago, we are now able to see some changes for the benefit of all Clubs, come to fruition. The introduction of a new band of registration fees, along with the introduction of new novice competitions should see larger participant numbers from all Clubs in both recreational and competitive diving categories. Diving Queensland looks forward to solid increases and support from all Clubs in achieving this.

The introduction and implementation of our interclub competition is another exciting addition to the competition calendar, which will provide a new facet to diving in Queensland, while meeting our ongoing strategic planning goals.

## Coaching

It was very pleasing to see a Level 1 Course held in October of this year. By all accounts, the weekend course was a huge success. We welcome our newly accredited Level 1 coaches. Thank you to Dianne Smith for coordinating this course, and we look forward to more courses being available in the coming year.

## Officiating

Several of our members have seen upgrades to their judging levels over the last 12 months, which is a testament to the hard work put in at both domestic and interstate competitions by these individuals. We pride ourselves on the high standard that our judges conduct themselves, so it is always pleasing when DA recognise this. Thanks goes to Kevin Hall, who has been instrumental in ensuring Qld judges continue to be recognised and upgraded by DA in accordance with the Officiating criteria.

## Competitions

Nearly all Competitions held in the past twelve months were well attended, however lack of nominations caused the cancellation of some. It is incumbent on all Clubs (and Members) to be aware of when and where these events are on the Calendar and ensure they plan for attendance.

The Competitions Committee is always endeavouring to get our volunteers to commit to all the Qualifying Competitions and State Championships (as well as Nationals) that are held. Volunteering is an integral part of our sport and quite rewarding for those who assist; however, more is needed to give those few a break from the commitment. We thank Toni Toohey, Maxine Boyd and Heidi Graymore for their tireless efforts in the organisation and running of everything competition related.

School Sport Trials were held in the first half of the year. The Queensland team attended the Australian School Sport Diving Championships In Melbourne. For many, it was their first time representing Qld in school sports. Thank you to Heidi Graymore for the organisation and management of the team, and also to Lucy Snell for accompanying the team as our registered teacher. Planning and preparation is already underway, in conjunction with Queensland School Sport for the Pacific School Games to be held in Adelaide in November 2015.

The Competitions Committee were extremely fortunate to have been able to hold a Bunnings BBQ to acquire much needed equipment. This, coupled with a grant application, will hopefully see Queensland with its own set of iPads. This will hugely improve our competitions.

## Membership

Over the past few years, membership has not grown at the level we would have liked, and it is imperative that this change in order to maintain our funding. All clubs need to be active in registering all members, whether recreational or competitive, and with a mindset of future directions, Clubs can bring about this change.

The registration database is finalised and now all registrations in every category can be implemented by visiting our new look web site [www.divingqld.org.au](http://www.divingqld.org.au) This system significantly reduces the work load for Club volunteers which is an obvious bonus.

## Media

We are grateful to Diving Australia for their assistance in implementing the web site. The savings to Diving Queensland into the future is considerable. Updating of the information it contains, and updating of our Facebook page will continue as required.

## Congratulations

Congrats to all recipients of trophies (listed in other parts of the report), and our thanks are extended to Steve Minnikin MP for attending the presentation day. Thanks also to those who organised the day and provided the crowds with a sausage sizzle and of course, the trophies.

## Conclusion

In conclusion, and on behalf the Board, we are very grateful to the State Government, Diving Australia, School Sport Queensland, Sponsors and all other agencies with whom we work. We would struggle even more to succeed without this much needed assistance, so thanks indeed.

Thank you to all the unnamed volunteers behind the scenes who don't get the recognition they deserve, but know you make a difference with the help you provide our Association, and the opportunities given our Divers. I thank Paul Stafford for his service to Diving Queensland, as President, Judge, and for his advice during my time as Acting President. My personal thanks go to the Board, Peter, Michele, Di, Steve and Sue, and to Janne, who have assisted me in this transition period and I look forward to a positive future working together.

Teamwork is essential to ensuring the productive future for Diving Queensland - the only area for competition is in the pool, and positive results are always enhanced when this attitude is foremost.

### Volunteers

Most sporting organisations will tell you that they survive due to a strong volunteer base. There is no doubt that Diving Queensland has a solid base of volunteers, but of course, the call for more people to assist is always loud. Encouragements of all people both within and external to the sport, allow others to engage and feel a part of this sport as well as a Club and Diving Queensland. ### State Government

We are grateful for the assistance received from the Department Officers. Their advice and attention to our sport is most gratifying, and we enjoy a mutual respect for what is sometimes a difficult role. We are completing the first year of the three year funding cycle, 2014-2016 and we are on-track across all elements of both our Strategic Plan and accompanying Operation Plan.

As Full registration of all individuals joining this fantastic sport is essential. Not to undertake registration of every member of every Club, not only puts an unnecessary financial burden on both Diving Queensland and to a lesser extent Diving Australia, the load on those members who are being registered appropriately, actually find that it costs more to "do the right thing." Additional to this is the rights of the members. Each member is entitled to the correct registration and insurance coverage as decided by the parent body. Not to undertake this procedure is at the very least, poor judgement on behalf of those Clubs and individuals responsible for this potentially unethical practice.

A major part of the Governments practise is to fund according to participation and increased participation rates, hence the need for fully registered membership,

### Available Grants

The State Government has released over the past twelve months, a variety of Grants opportunities which are constantly advertised to Clubs and individuals. The Gambling Community Benefit Fund is no doubt one of the best schemes for Clubs to apply for, along with several other State and Civic Government and private opportunities. Get in the Game is a suite of State Government grants available for many individuals and is often over-subscribed, so it is important for Club officials to advise those members who may be eligible for funding.

### Queensland Academy of Sport

QAS Diving is a partnership programme and is aimed at fast tracking the development of Queensland's young talented divers that demonstrate the potential to excel at an elite level. Diving Queensland is very fortunate to have the backing of Diving Australia to ensure that the diving programme is maintained within the Queensland Academy of Sport. It is hoped that continuing positive assistance from the QAS is maintained.

### Membership

As one of the KPI's in the DQ Strategic Plan, many hours have been devoted to the Recreational Diving Programme. This is one of the most successful partnerships with the Brisbane City Council Chill Out scheme, and attendance is always at capacity. Clubs need to embrace this concept while at the same time understand that while Diving Queensland continues with this strategy, that they the Clubs will reap the rewards from any increased membership.

### "Get On Board"

The tag to rally all/any individuals into the fold, and to create a chance for divers to enjoy the art of springboard and platform diving, has been replicated in many ways, and should be used as frequently as possible. This obvious 'play-on-words' fits this organisation well.

### Conclusion

Many thanks to the Board of Directors for the role that you play in this Association and of course the commitment and dedication to that role. To those who are not seeking re-election, your commitment is known and appreciated - many thanks for all your efforts.

'Unsung heroes' are many in an organisation such as Diving Queensland. PDC has over 30 divers attending, some from the USA and even Mexico, It will be a great event with a great attendance of top Australian and DQ judges putting up their hands to assist.

I will look forward to working with you all again, over the upcoming competition season. I wish all the best to the Judges, Divers and Coaches in their future goals.

### Selection Panel Report

In March 2014 the Selector's, selected the Queensland State Challenge team which consisted of Mary Holgate, Michael Leonard, Mark Teoh and Toby Snell. The team dived extremely well bringing Queensland into 3rd place in the overall results. The Selectors decided to add more to the criteria of the SDS, so the athletes would be more accountable to remain in the Squad.

Over the past 12 months there were five SDS Clinics held, with Mathew Helm as the external Coach these Clinics proved to be a worthy exercise for all concerned.

The Selector had a meeting in August to Select the State Development Squad for 2014-15 year. A Squad of 10 of the 12 athletes who applied were selected.

The Selectors in a unanimous decision to add more to the SDS criteria to read:

the Selectors will meet for a review of the athletes performances after the last competition each Calendar year, of which members must have reached qualifying for the Nationals in the following year, on at least one board, then again in February all members must have reached qualifying on two boards to remain in the Squad. As the SDS is the pinnacle of athlete recognition the State has to offer, this makes the members accountable for their position in the Squad.

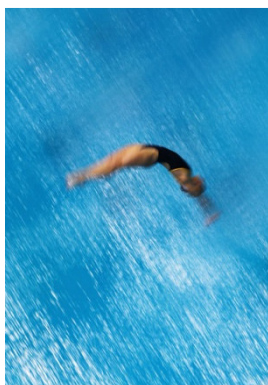
